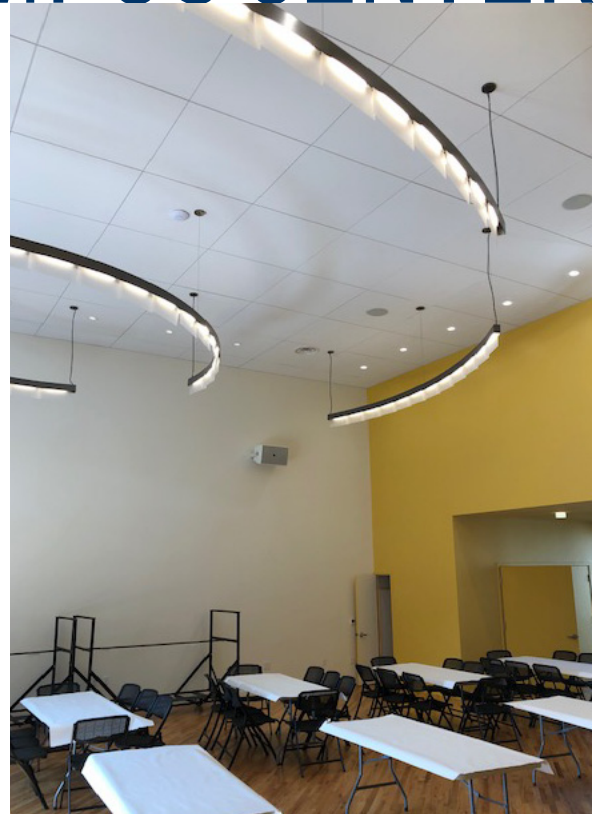


LIGHTING FOR A CAMPUS CENTER

For the principal meeting space, a two-story volume in the newly renovated Hillel Center, the custom fixture was designed in an arrangement to suggest a place of gathering by using concentric forms radiating around a focal point in the space.

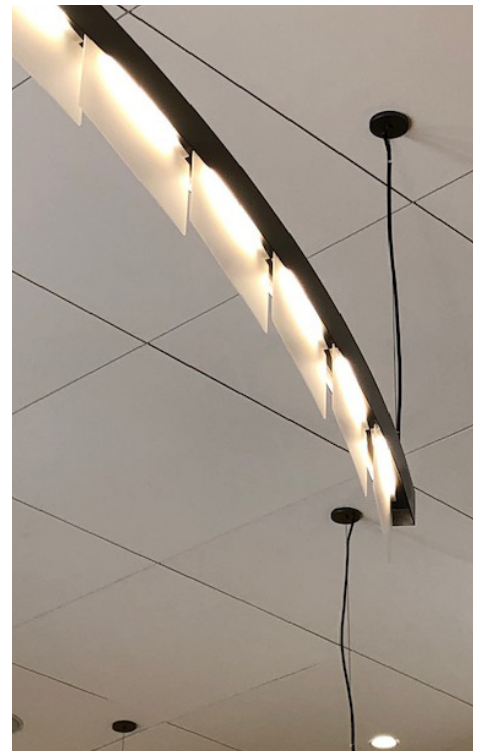
The LED up and downlight, separately circuited within each arc, lent functionality. The satin acrylic panels serve as light baffles, softly illuminating the downlight, but also picking up window light during the day. Standard pendants were used in circulation spaces.
