Built in 1915, this historic renovation repurposed this building to create additional classroom space. Designed by George McDougall, the State Architect at the time, the building is rich in detailed brickwork, classic brick arches and stone balconies.

Borden Lighting provided custom chandeliers for the auditorium, which are scaled up versions of the original fixtures that were lost. We also provided exterior post and wall mounted fixtures based on photos of original fixtures, as well as "schoolhouse" pendants updated with CF lamping and integral emergency battery packs.
