This new Napa Valley luxury resort has applied for a LEED Platinum rating. The facility makes extensive use of recycled wood, geo-thermal heating and extensive photovoltaic panels. Food for the restaurant is grown on-site and fertilized with compost produced on-site. The facility proves that sustainability can be both beautiful and luxurious.

Borden Lighting is proud to have been part of the sustainability efforts of the project. Both the 720 wedge and the 716 medallion wall mounts combine cast aluminum parts with 100% recycled content and bronze which has 90% recycled content. The natural Bronze finish on both fixtures has less impact on air and water quality while using less energy compared to fixtures that are made from aluminum and painted. Both fixtures use high efficiency CF lamps.
